



Movement of the Rook and the King

How the piece Rook and King look like?



White Rook



Black King

How the piece Rook and King move on the chess board?

The rook moves horizontally or vertically, through any number of unoccupied squares. When capturing pieces, the rook occupies the square on which the enemy piece sits. But if the rook blocks by own piece, he cannot jump over it.

A king can move one square in any direction (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally) unless the square is already occupied by a friendly piece or the move would place the king in check
